

## **SAM Learning**

Pupils now have 24/7 access to SAM Learning - an online resource similar to Doodle and Moodle.

SAM Learning contains thousands of revision activities, across many KS3 and GCSE subjects - and is particularly good for quick review checks on learning.

Some staff may set work via SAM Learning, so your son/daughter needs to be able to log in. *Please remember that the main way of setting work will be via Doodle, but your son/daughter may be directed to Moodle or SAM Learning.*

To log in, he/she needs:

The website address: [www.samlearning.com](http://www.samlearning.com)

Our school centre ID: RM1CS

Their username: their date of birth followed by initials, in the format DDMMYYII

Their password: if they have not yet logged in, this is the same as their username.

*Example: 010806DJ is the User ID for David Jones born 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 2006.*

*It is advised that pupils keep a record of their access details in their homework journal.*
